
# Expanded information for continuing accreditation

### The Audit of the Inquiry Brief


Target: "Ninety-six percent of our students pass the Elementary Education MTTC exam and 80% pass the Subject Area MTTC exams on their first attempt" (page 12). Probe: Get the MTTC results for Elementary Education and Subject Area for 2009-10, 2010-11, and 2011-12 to verify. Finding: Present 2 tables: list scores of all elementary ed students in the 3 years and list scores of all secondary ed students in the 3 years. Note the percentage passing on first attempt.


### **IB** Commission Review
