The Education Department at Erskine College invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of assistant/associate professor beginning August 2017. Applicants should demonstrate a strong commitment to undergraduate teaching in an academically rigorous Christian liberal arts environment that emphasizes the intentional integration of faith and learning.

Responsibilities include

Writing and facilitating the CAEP (Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation) accreditation program and teaching. Additionally, according to skills and expertise the candidate may perform other duties.

Qualifications:

- Embrace, support, and promote the Erskine College's Christian mission and philosophy of Christian higher education
- Doctorate from an accredited university (terminal degree (Ph.D. or Ed.D)) in curriculum and instruction emphasis in Literacy/Reading
- Experience at the P-12 level in public schools. At least three-five years of P-12 public school teaching experience in early childhood/elementary or special education
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Experience with accreditation documents e.g. CAEP accreditation. Knowledge and training in CAEP
- Notable record of scholarship, teaching and service in higher education

- Knowledge of assessment trends and best practices in assessment of student learning outcomes and program outcomes
- Ability to assume responsibility for tasks with considerable independence
- Ability to think and act creatively with people, information and ideas
- Record of experience designing and implementing initiatives that lead to improvement of teacher education programming
- Knowledge and understanding of and experience with program assessment
