## Job Duties:

The Assistant Dean, under the direction of the Dean, operates functioning processes for two assessment systems of Teacher Education programs in the College of Education and Human Services --- the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) Standards Assessment System, and the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) System of Teacher Candidate Assessments. The Assistant Dean ensures that all program assessments for CAEP and PDE are completed according to the system plan, including ensuring that data is collected and stored in Livetext/Watermark. A major leadership role of the Assistant Dean includes authority to maintain accountability and provide assurance that faculty members, stakeholders, clinical practitioners, and program completers regularly analyze and review candidate progress on an ongoing basis, for the purposes of documented, data-driven program improvement. Additionally, the Assistant Dean manages the policies and processes of student teachers earning certification in the Pennsylvania Department of Education. The Assistant Dean will directly supervise a SCUPA Professional employee who is the Director of Educational Field Experiences.

- Certification and experience as a teacher or in a related services field
- Experience in higher education or related services field

- Experience designing and implementing processes of a Quality Assurance System.
