Chair Position: Department of Advanced Education Programs

Description of Position: The chair of the Department of Advanced Education Programs (AEP) at Fort Hays State University (FHSU) occupies a tenure/tenure track, 12-month, full-time, unclassified position. Currently, AEP has over 1,500 candidates; the vast majority are virtual students. The chair oversees approximately 18 FTE faculty members and 30 adjuncts.

- 1. Earned doctorate degree in appropriate related areas from an accredited institution
- 2. Professional experience equivalent to the rank of an Associate Professor
- 3. Demonstrated commitment to research and service
- 4. Higher education leadership experience
- 5. College or university instructional experience
- 6. Application of innovative instructional technology experience
- 7. Accreditation experience

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Professional experience equivalent to the rank of Full Professor
- 2. Strategic planning and fundraising experience
- 3. P-12 experience
- 4. Recruitment and managing departmental growth experience
- 5. International education experience

Application Procedures: The search will remain open until a well-qualified appointee is identified. To ensure full consideration, applicants must submit the following:

- Letter of interest which addresses the required qualifications/experience described above;
- A statement of teaching philosophy;

- A vision statement describing what a graduate education program should be to serve a ethnically, culturally, and technologically, pedagogically, and content knowledge, diverse society;
- Current vita; and
- Information necessary to contact five (5) references

Compensation: Commensurate with appointee's experience, qualifications, and credentials meeting the requirements set forth by FHSU.
