General Description:

The University of Saint Mary invites applications for the Department Chair of Education. This tenure-track position will start July 2017.

Located in Leavenworth, Kansas, the University of Saint Mary is a private, Roman Catholic, liberal arts university.

The Department Chair is the academic leader and chief administrator within the Education Department. S/he provides for managing the daily operations of the department, and for positioning the department to meet the needs of the constituencies that it serves. In addition to leading the department, the chair assists in the recruiting for the department's programs, oversees the department's KSDE and CAEP accreditation, and serves as an intermediary between the faculty and administration of the University. Renewal as Chair will be determined annually.

The department offers undergraduate programs in Child Development, Elementary Education, Secondary Education licensure for students who major in Biology, Chemistry, English, Mathematics, History and Government, and Drama and Theater. This position is a 12-month tenure track appointment, at the rank of associate or full professor. S/he should be able to teach in the areas of education program offerings. The incumbent will teach three courses per semester (9 credit hours), generally at the undergraduate level on the main campus, but, at times, could teach graduate students at the university's extended campus in Overland Park, Kansas.
