



Faculty Position in Education

Assistant Professor, full-time, tenure-track position

QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D./Ed.D. preferred, master's considered, in Elementary Education, Curriculum or a related field, teaching credentials (El. Ed. or Early Childhood and the Reading Endorsement), at least three years of successful teaching in a P-5 classroom or a reading classroom. Effective teaching in a higher education classroom preferred, but not required. Ph.D./Ed.D. required for tenure.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and graduate or other education and literacy classes, student teaching supervision, recruiting and advising. Additional opportunities to teach in Bluffton's Enduring Values general education program are available.

COMPENSATION: Commensurate with education and experience within the university pay scale.
