

Dean of Education

Fitchburg State University seeks applications and nominations for the position of dean of education, which reports directly to the provost. The dean will be expected to assume office in July 2016 or as soon thereafter as is feasible.

Fitchburg State University is a public comprehensive institution with a strong and proud tradition of excellence in teaching, scholarship, and public service, and is situated on a 60-acre traditional New England campus in North Central Massachusetts, 50 miles west of Boston. Founded as a teachers' college in 1894, Fitchburg State has developed into a highly-regarded institution that blends liberal arts and sciences and professional programs within a small college environment and recently updated facilities. The university prepares students to lead, serve, and succeed by fostering lifelong learning and civic and global responsibility. A Fitchburg State education extends beyond the classroom to include residential, professional, and co-curricular opportunities, with particular emphasis on internships. This school provides students in teacher preparation programs numerous opportunities to work in a variety of real-life settings, including access to classrooms where they can observe and teach. Without leaving the campus, teacher candidates can combine what they are learning in their courses with what occurs in public school classrooms and, thus, enhance their understanding of educational theory and practice.
