Assistant Professor in Social Studies Education

The Department of Teacher Education in the Judith Herb College of Education at The University of Toledo is seeking a tenure track assistant professor of Social Studies teacher education with teaching and research strengths in social studies teacher education, a commitment to urban education, and a readiness to partner with local schools to provide transformative teacher education. The successful candidate will teach undergraduate and graduate teacher education courses in social studies curriculum and pedagogy. The candidate will also be required to maintain connections with local schools and develop a line of scholarly inquiry leading to publication in social studies teacher education or a related field. Additionally, she/he is expected to collaborate within the department and university in a wide range of related duties, which may include: developing curriculum, recruiting, advising, supervising, and assisting with securing grants.

Applicants must have a Doctoral degree or all but dissertation (in progress with completion date at time of appointment, August 2020) in social studies education or a related field. Five or more years of experience in social studies teaching is required. Experience teaching social studies education courses, including using an online platform, is preferred. The successful candidate should demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively. Additionally, the ability to work effectively with traditional and non-traditional students is desired. Candidates with expertise in core academic content and/or online instruction are especially encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to those who have knowledge and experience in program assessment for CAEP/NCSS accreditation.

Applicants must log into <u>utoledo.edu/jobs</u> to upload cover letter, Curriculum Vita, recent publications and presentations, statement of teaching philosophy, and names and contact information for three references. The committee will request letters of recommendation for finalist.
