The Dean will be charged with promoting and implementing a shared vision for the College that will support the University's commitment to teaching excellence and advance its mission to provide rigorous general education, high quality undergraduate programs and graduate programs in the liberal arts and education, professional/pre-professional preparation, and integrative real-world experiences, both local and global, for the students.
